

Living among fallen people in a fallen world we will know the disbelief and disappointment of broken promises.

WHY ARE PROMISES BROKEN?

- dishonest <u>intention</u> (I won't)
- internal <u>unreliability</u> (I forgot)
- external <u>interference</u> (I can't)
- changed <u>circumstance</u> (I could ...
 but ...)
- changed <u>priority</u> (I no longer care)
- changed <u>perception</u> (I no longer think I should)

Saul > <u>admired</u> by David Mark > <u>trusted</u> by Paul Gomer > <u>married</u> to Hosea Judas > <u>chosen</u> by Jesus 1. Remember your own imperfections.

"Let him who has no sin among you cast the first stone" (John 8:7)

2. Forgive even when you no longer trust

3. LIFE STRATEGY: Hold <u>human</u> promises <u>lightly</u>

"Stop trusting in man who has but a breath in his nostrils. Of what account is he?" (Isaiah 2:22)

4. Realize that God alone is <u>totally</u> <u>trustworthy</u>

"Lord, to whom can we go? You alone have the words of life" (John 6:68)

5. Pour your pain out <u>unto God</u> and seek his <u>healing</u> rather than seeking pity or revenge

6. Keep <u>your own</u> promises, whether others keep their promises or not.

The NT refers to God as "he who promised" and then describes God as "faithful"

Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. (Hebrews 10:23)

God's promises ... no <u>collateral</u> or <u>proof</u> except HIMSELF

- No analogy or comparison or example available!
- His promises are in a class unto themselves!

God's promises motivate us

"Since we have these promises, my friends, let us purify ourselves ..."

(II Corinthians 7:1)

Sometimes God's promises are beyond our <u>earthly perspective</u>. But they are kept and fulfilled, even when we <u>struggle</u> to <u>understand</u> "how"

For no matter how many promises God has made, they are "Yes" in Christ. (II Corinthians 1:20)

Some of God's promises are only valid for those who <u>actually</u> <u>believe</u> the promise.

If those who live by the law are heirs, then faith has no value and the promise is worthless ... the promise comes through faith ... (Romans 4:14-16)
