

The Ear Solution



eardrum cochlea anvil eustachian tube stirrup auricle


outer ear canal hammer











Turn your ear to wisdom and apply your heart to understanding.

(Proverbs 2:2)

My son, pay attention to my wisdom, listen well to my words of insight.

(Proverbs 5:1)

Give ear and come to me. Hear me that your soul may live. (Isaiah 55:3)

Hearing with the <u>heart</u> ... suggested by reference to <u>posture</u>

God **HEARD** his people grumbling **against** him and groaning **to** him.

God HEARS our prayers today.

The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry. (Psalm 34:15)

O you who HEAR PRAYER, to you all men will come. (Psalm 65:2)

This is the confidence that we have in approaching God, that if we ask anything according to his will, HE HEARS US. (I John 5:14)

A Christian who **HEARS** God is actually one who **obeys** what God communicates.

This was the <u>call</u> of the prophets and the <u>command</u> of Jesus.

Though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you the elementary truths of God's word all over again. You need milk instead of solid food. We have much to say about this, but it is hard to explain because you have become dull of hearing ["selective" hearing] (NIV = slow to learn) (Hebrews 5:11-12)

A Christian who does not **grow** is "dull of hearing"

- We are used to the <u>audible</u> voice.
- The voice of God must be listened for with our <u>spirit</u>.
- It may be a mere whisper to our conscious mind.
- But the voice of the Lord can be heard when <u>we</u> <u>listen</u>.

A time is coming (and has now come) when the dead will **hear** the voice of the Son of God, and those who hear will live. They have crossed from death to life.

(John 5:24-25)

*referring to the physical death of the Christian ... departure of the spirit

Do not be amazed at this, for a time is coming when all who are in their graves will hear his voice and come out. Those who have done good will rise to live, and those who have done evil will rise to be condemned. (John 5:28-29) *referring to the resurrection of the body ... return of the spirit
