I CAN ANSWER THE SKEPTICS!



## Many folks are skeptical:

- God <u>exists</u>
- God <u>communicates</u>
- God is independent of/supreme over <u>nature</u> or <u>science</u>
- God has a plan
- God <u>intervenes</u> <u>into</u> human history
- God is good
- God has <u>expectations</u> and <u>accountability</u> for mankind

One thing God has spoken, two things I have heard. You, O God, are strong, and you, O God, are loving. Surely you will reward each person according to what he has done. (Psalm 62:11-12)

## SKEPTICAL LOGIC

1. I accept only **proof** ... no consideration or room for **faith** 

\*Return of Christ (vs. 4)

Because something has <u>not yet</u> happened, it therefore <u>cannot</u> and <u>will not</u> happen.

 I am willing to ignore anything not agreeing with my own <u>preconceived</u> <u>idea</u>

\*Return of Christ cf. Noah's flood (vs. 5)

It is convenient to forget that history is filled with "<u>first time ever</u>" events.

- 3. I only accept <u>human</u> reasoning, measurements, analysis, or explanations.
  - \*Return of Christ ... promise vs. long wait (vs. 8-9)

God's methods, timing, goals, and purposes are often <u>unfamiliar</u> or even <u>unfathomable</u> to our human minds.

Oh, the depth of the riches and wisdom and knowledge of God. How unsearchable his judgements, and his paths beyond tracing out! Who has known the mind of the Lord? Who has been his counselor? Who has ever given to God that God should repay him? For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be glory forever! (Romans 11:33-36)

## Christ's return ... is a **promise**

- The "day and hour" was <u>purposely</u>
   <u>withheld</u> (intentionally omitted)
   from that promise
- How foolish to disbelieve when we have been told that we <u>do not</u> have all the <u>details</u>.

## "But the day of the Lord will come LIKE A THIEF." (vs 10)

 People whose home has never been vandalized still lock their doors based on the <u>possibility</u> of a thief. Those who say "It cannot happen because it has not happened" are quite foolish. I CAN ANSWER THE SKEPTICS!
