Deny self = his agenda



Why the symbol of the cross?

- Following CHRIST rather than SELF involves a <u>mighty</u> <u>struggle!</u>
- Humanly speaking, it is <u>impossibly</u>
 <u>hard</u> to be saved!

Jesus loved him and said, "Go sell everything... " At this the man's face fell and he went away SAD because he had great wealth. Jesus said, "How HARD it is to enter the kingdom of God! It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle..." "Who then can be saved?" Jesus replied, "With man this is IMPOSSIBLE, but with God all things are possible."
