

In October 1527, an outbreak of the "plague" spread throughout Germany. As citizens in the city of Wittenburg began to die, Martin Luther wrote a song to voice the sovereign power of God over all earthly and spiritual forces.

## A MIGHTY FORTRESS IS OUR GOD ... A BULWARK NEVER FAILING OUR HELPER HE AMID THE FLOOD OF MORTAL ILLS PREVAILING ...

- based on Psalm 46
- gained immense popularity across Europe, was woven into the web of Reformation history, and became the true national hymn of Protestant Germany
- At times when he was discouraged or angry at political events, Luther would say to his friend, Philip Melanchthon, "Come Philip, let's sing Psalm 46".

## Many reasons to be AFRAID

- <u>trouble</u> (1)
- disasters (2-3)
- <u>wars</u> (6)

## Our <u>natural world</u> sometimes goes crazy.









## So also, our relationships go crazy.

One reason NOT to be AFRAID

"Be still and know that I AM GOD. I
will be exalted among the nations. I
will be exalted in the earth." (vs. 10)

The issue is being <u>still</u>, <u>humble</u>, and <u>trusting</u> enough to know God and realize his control. This "knowing" is not <u>theological</u> but <u>relational</u>. When I allow his peace to settle down over my soul, I have <u>entered</u> his <u>fortress</u>.







A REFUGE is a place beyond the reach of trouble or danger. When I am **protected** then I **do not** need to fear the presence of danger or enemy.







A RIVER ... visual symbol of a **nonending supply** ... Flowing day and night, it is nonstop, ever present, instantly available source of **goodness** and **gladness**.

Many fallen powers and civilizations bear testimony to God's <u>overthrow</u> of those who <u>oppose</u> his plan and his people. History is a REMINDER that God has persistently <u>limited</u> and <u>crushed</u> man's evil intentions.
