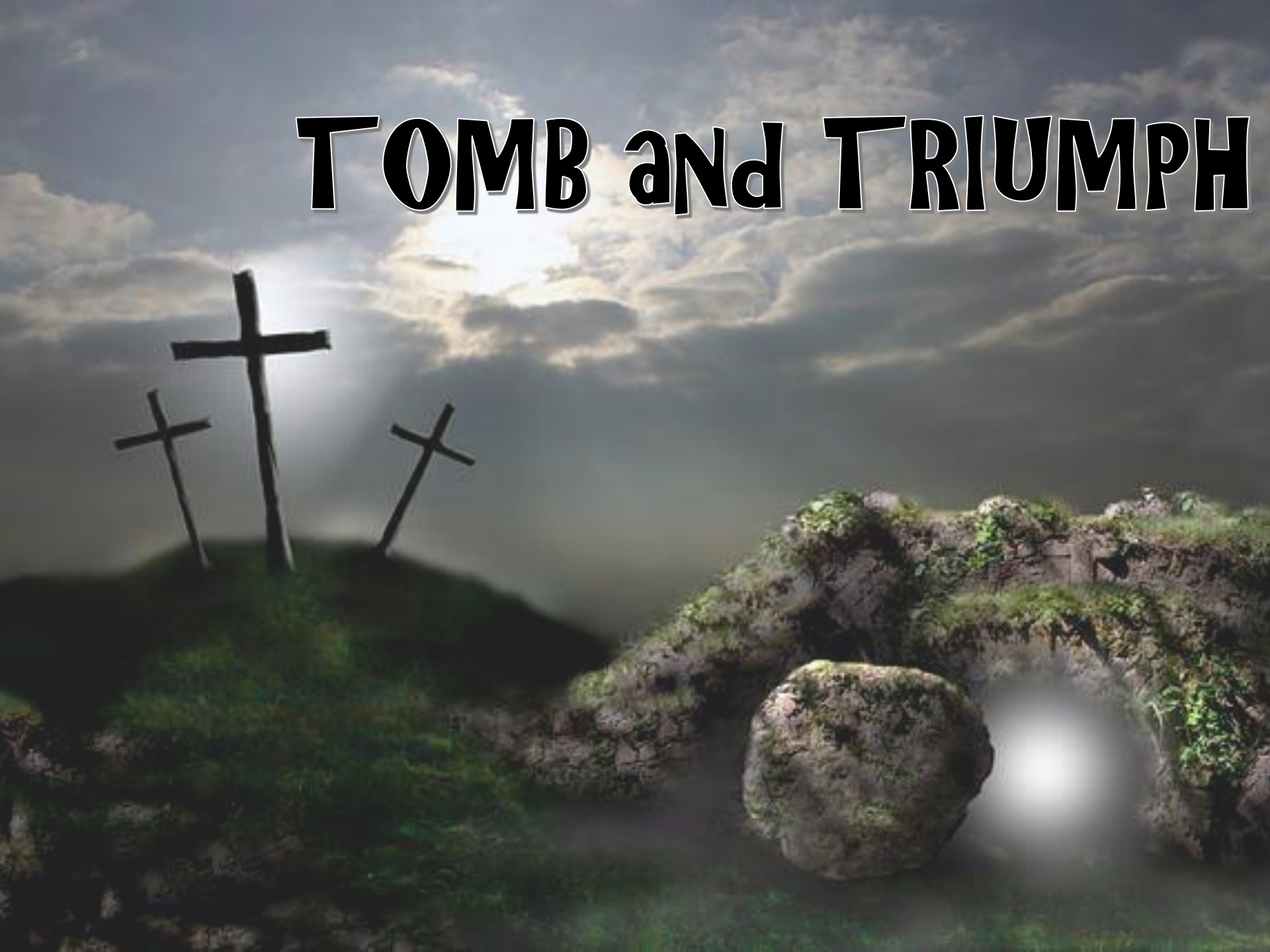


TOMB and TRIUMPH






EUcharist

eat this bread.***


***In remembrance of Me,

search for truth.***


***In remembrance of Me

your heart yield to God.***




This is good and pleases God our Savior, who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. *(1 Timothy 2:4)*

But Christ appeared [and suffered] once for all at the culmination of the ages to do away with sin by sacrificing himself. (*Hebrews 9:26*)


For Christ suffered once for all sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God. (*1 Peter 3:18*)
