











HONOR? Karod = <u>heavy</u> (recognition of <u>importance</u>)

Youth Attitude = respect Action = obey

Children, obey your parents (in the Lord), for this is right. "Honor your father and mother", which is the first commandment with a promise, that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth. Fathers, do not exasperate your children. Instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:1-4)

Adult Attitude = responsibility Action = provide

Do not rebuke an older man harshly, but exhort him as if he were your father. Treat younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, and younger women as sisters, with absolute purity.

If a widow has children or grandchildren, these should learn first of all to put their religion into practice by CARING for their own family and so repaying their parents and grandparents, for this is pleasing to the Lord ... any woman who has widows in her own family should HELP them ... (I Timothy 5:1-5,16)

Parents are the means God uses to create each child

Parents are the proxies God uses to teach each child

Honor does not require enjoyment or agreement. Nor does it mean that the parent desires or deserves constant attention. In such cases, I seek to respect the role even when I cannot perfect the relationship

BUT I'M GROWN UP!

- ✓ The command to <u>obey</u> is terminated. The command to <u>honor</u> is not terminated.
- ✓ Responsibility "to" becomes responsibility "for"

JESUS

Attitude – sought to please and obey
Teaching – labeled "excuses" as <u>sin</u>

(Matthew 15:3-9)

Example – gave priority to parent's needs (John 19:25-27)
