YOU SHALL NOT STEAL.

(Exodus 20:17)

For many reason, God expects to RECOGNIZE the property/possessions of others as belonging to them and RESPECT the boundary of ownership. In fact, he expects us to REJOICE with others in what he has given to them.

Property/Possessions are a gift from God (Psalm 50)

"Ownership" is actually stewardship. Owners are accountable to God for their management. (Psalm 8)

God gave us laws that encouraged a person to work, earn, save, and own (Exodus 22:1-15)

Under Old Testament law, a thief was expected to make restitution and could even be sold into slavery if unable to repay (Exodus 22:3). Even a king had no right to confiscate property (I Kings 21).

PRINCIPLES OF INTEGRITY

Possessions are <u>God's</u> to give, not <u>man's</u> to steal.

Because God himself gives to every man life and breath and everything which they possess. (Acts 17:25)

Both <u>tangible</u> and <u>intangible</u> theft is wrong.

Slaves, obey your earthly masters in everything, and do it not only when their eye is on you (to win their favor) but with sincerity of heart and reverence for the Lord. Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men. (Colossians 3:22-23)

TALENTS > WORK > POSSESSIONS > GIFTS This is God's design and intention for humanity.

If you have been stealing you must steal no more. You must work, doing something useful with your own hands, that you may have something to share with those in need. (Ephesians 4:28)

YOU SHALL NOT COVET your neighbors house ... wife ... servant ... ox ... donkey. Or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

(Exodus 20:17)

Abundant <u>possessions/wealth</u> does not equal abundant <u>life</u>

Watch out! Be on your guard against all types of greed. A man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions. (Luke 12:15)

Desire for possessions <u>easily</u> overwhelms our desire for God.

Put to death whatever belongs to your earthly nature ... greed (which is <u>idolatry</u>). Because of these things, the wrath of God is coming. (Colossians 3:5-6)

The <u>more</u> we have, the <u>more</u> we are consumed by worldly responsibilities.

God's child can rest securely in what God has given them for that moment.

Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, "Never will I leave you. Never will I forsake you. "So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper. I will not be afraid." (Hebrews 13:5-6)
