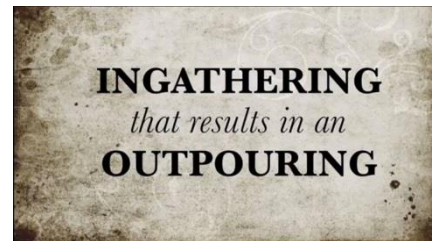

As God loves the widow, the orphan, the immigrant, or the exile, so he also loves the *divorced* (*Rom. 8:39*). As God loves marriage, so he also expects those who are married to love their marriage and deny their own self interests in order to make teamwork and companionship a true *reality* (*Phil. 2:3-4, 1 Cor. 7:4*). Any sin can be forgiven and any troubled marriage can be restored when hearts are surrendered to Christ and humility and mercy are given. (*1 Cor. 13:5-7, 1 Peter 3:8-9, 4:8, 1 Jn. 3:18-21*)
