

JANUARY SERMON SERIES



*This parable is often interpreted as picturing the “second coming” of Christ. It does. But its meaning is much wider. Millions of people across the generations have already had their moment of “meeting” with God. They either had oil in their lamps (prepared) or their lamp was empty and the door was shut. THE OIL NEEDED FOR OUR LAMP IS CHRIST. There is no exception and no other preparation. Each person must make certain of their own lamp.
