FATHER TIME does a twist on Saturday night ... set clocks back ... DST is finished!





When it comes to “giving”; all sorts of songs, sermons, and slogans have been trotted out. “*The gift that keeps on giving*”, “*One live to give*”, “*Live to give*”, etc. Some are profound. Some are corny. Jesus, of course, taught about giving. “*Give and it will be given unto you.*” And Jesus also touched on a delicate topic, that of an unacceptable gift. Perhaps you have been there. You were given a gift, but you actually felt insulted ... by the attitude or the amount or the thoughtlessness. This is awkward. Jesus described how God feels toward the gifts we offer him. Yes, sometimes God feels insulted or angry at our lackluster giving. During November, we’ll look at three parables from Jesus. **MIFFED AT THE GIFT**
