




A special day with one of our missionaries!

HOW CAN A MAN BE RIGHTEOUS BEFORE GOD?

(Job 25)

Job's	comp	laint:
<u> </u>	COLLID	<u> </u>

- a) God's hand is heavy on me [negative!] (23:2)
- b) Aha! He is not angry at me, but he is testing me [positive!] (23:10)
- c) That I can handle! (23:10)
- d) HOWEVER! God allows renegades and rebels to get away with murder. (24:12)

Bildad's reply: a) God is
Duh! Keeping God at a safe distance allows us to worship him, but does not allow him to help us. Bildad does not believe it is for a to be righteous/pure in God's eyes.
Duh! The fact that God is to his creation does not mean that he it. Nor did he create a step-down universe in which the thing created was the thing created, the "runt" of the litter. On the contrary! God described all the and of nature as "good," then excitedly described the and as "very good." (Genesis 1)
Duh! In Bildad's logic, "calling a person "righteous" is they are on God's level, God's equal." He did not comprehend that God himself can a person to be righteous (not morally perfect, but considered so!) on the basis of their (Abraham Genesis 15:6) and on the basis of God's of perfectly righteous substitutes. (Romans 3:21-26)
*My righteousness is not given (credential), but God's righteousness is given (gift) (Philippians 3:7-9)
*Tragically, because of Adams's disobedience, I am a (no choice). Triumphantly, because of Christ's obedience, I am (my choice). (Romans 5:15-19)
