THE MYSTERY OF HISTORY (Acts 17:26)

CYRUS, King of Persia (600 - 529 B.C.)

When Isaiah predicted the release of Babylon's captives by Cyrus, the captivity had not even taken place, and Cyrus had not yet been born. God himself explains the purpose of this (exceptionally early; exceptionally specific) prophecy as preventing the Israelite people from saying, "Well, that's just how it happened" (Isaiah 48:3-6). NO. It did not "just happen." God used one militaristic and pagan king to overthrow/punish a different king and release his captive subjects. Josephus (historian, 37 - 90 A.D.) says that Cyrus repatriated the Jews because he had heard of this prophecy about himself and wanted to make it come true. Perhaps that is the very reason God had it written down in advance!

Cyrus illustrates the mysterious dilemma of believing that God ______human history while giving humans a ______to choose their own actions. That he can coordinate people who are ______and events that are ______and fold them into his larger purpose is a mystery. Through faith we must say, "Though I do not fathom ______ or _____, God accomplishes ______divine ______ in human history."
