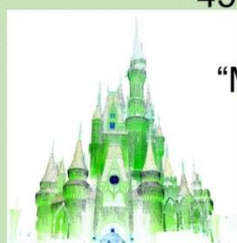

## ATTITUDE of Praise (vs. 1)
