

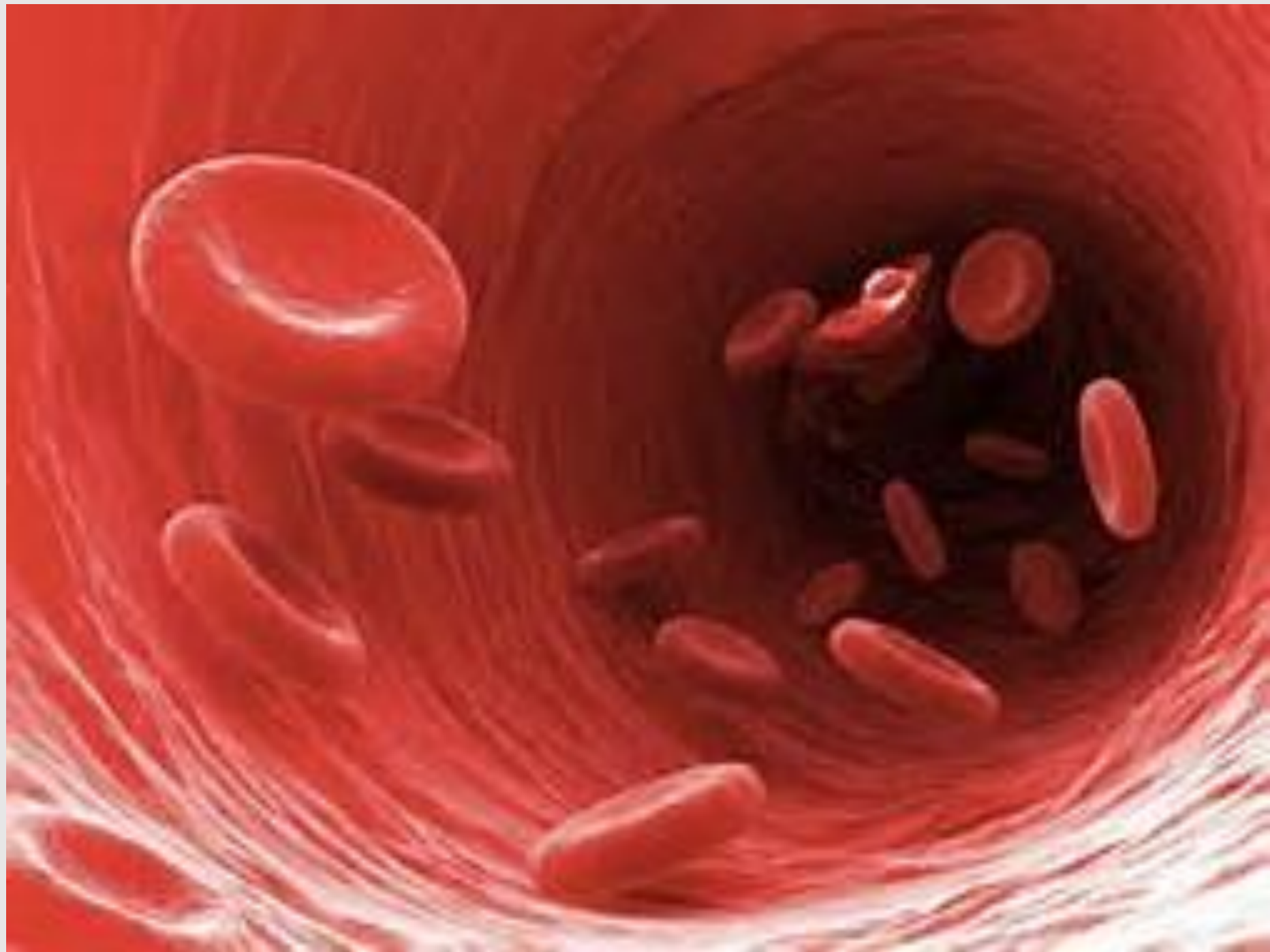

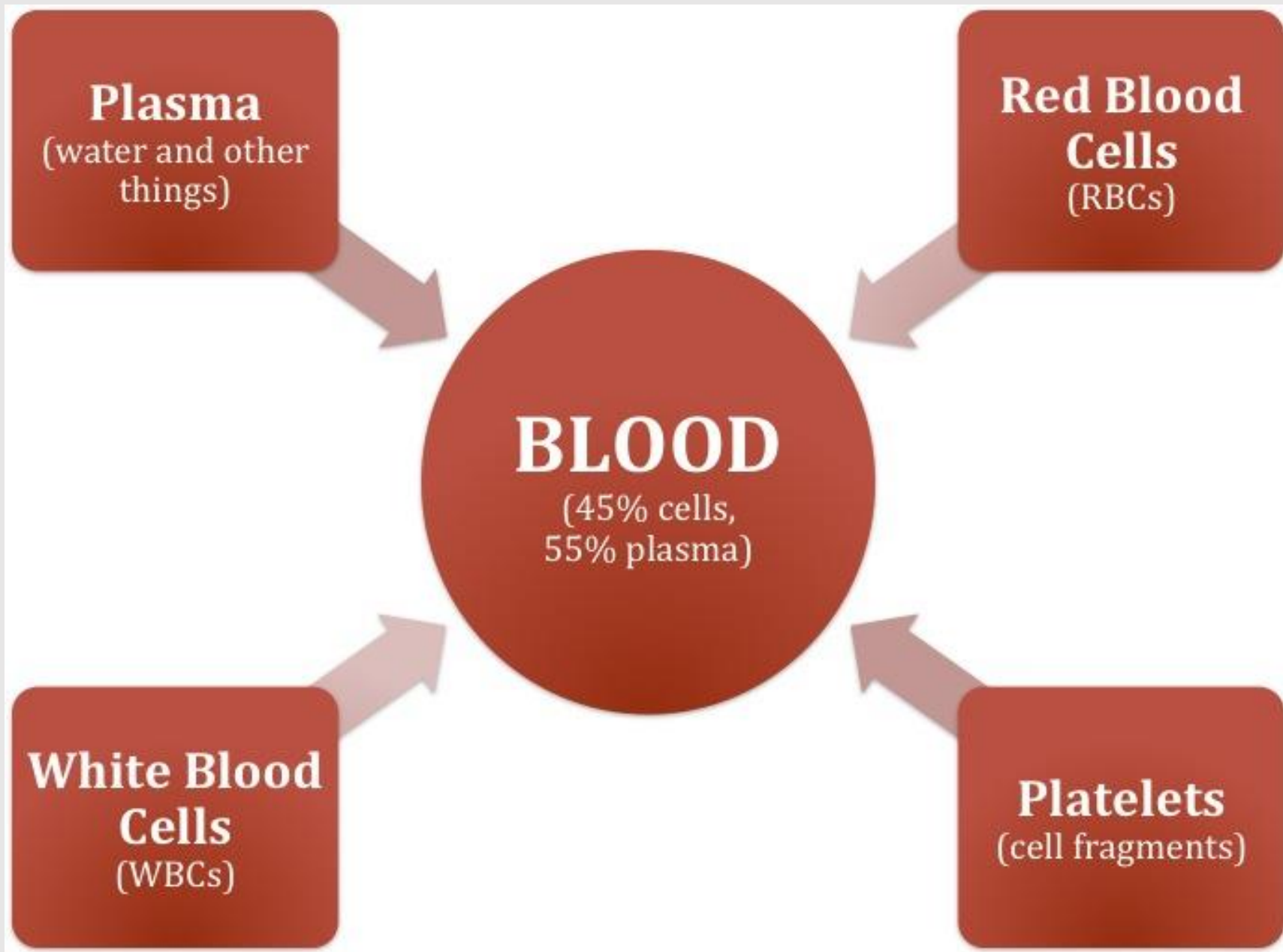
Blood is **LIFE!**

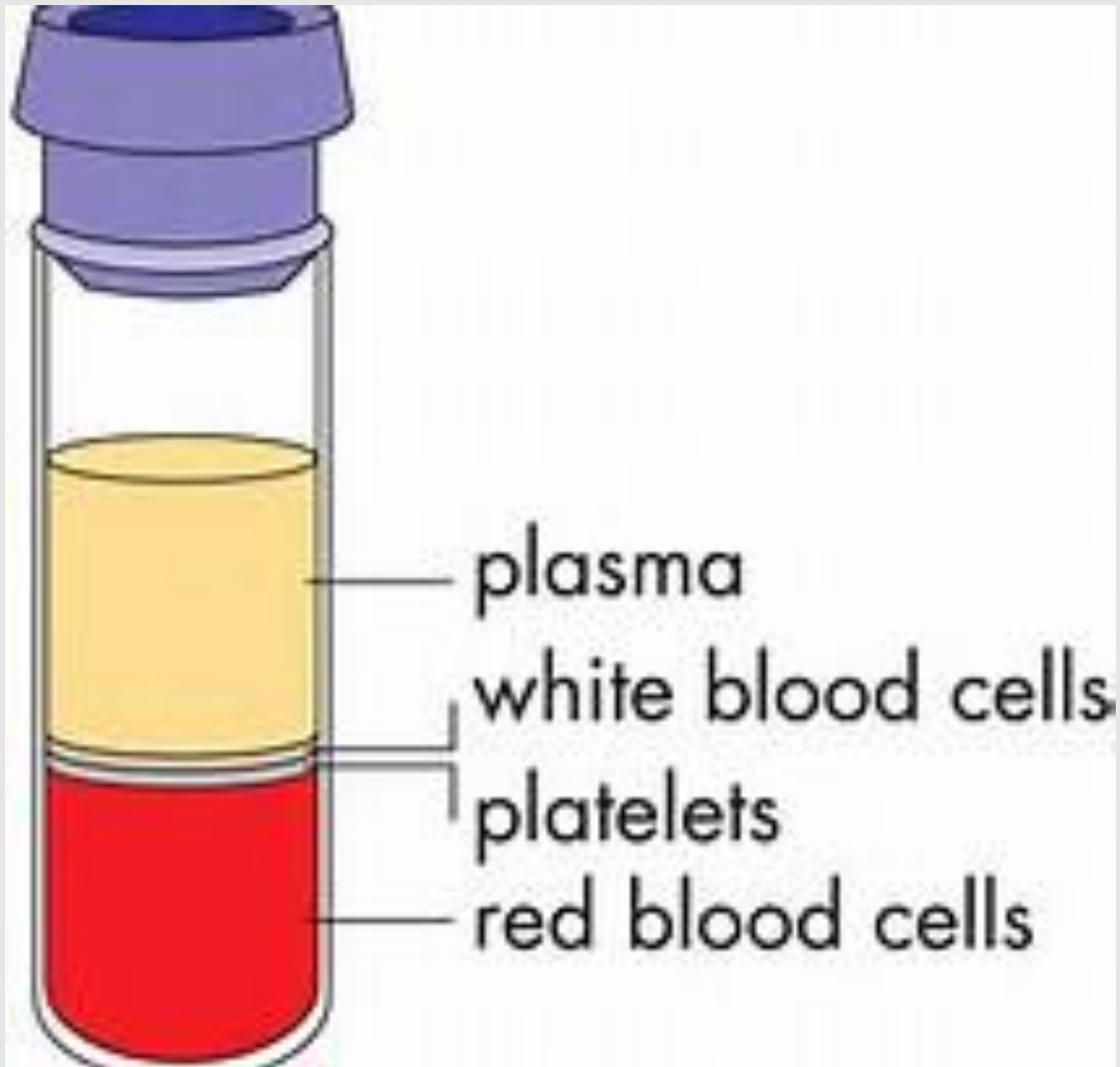
Blood **feeds** and **sustains**
every cell in my body.

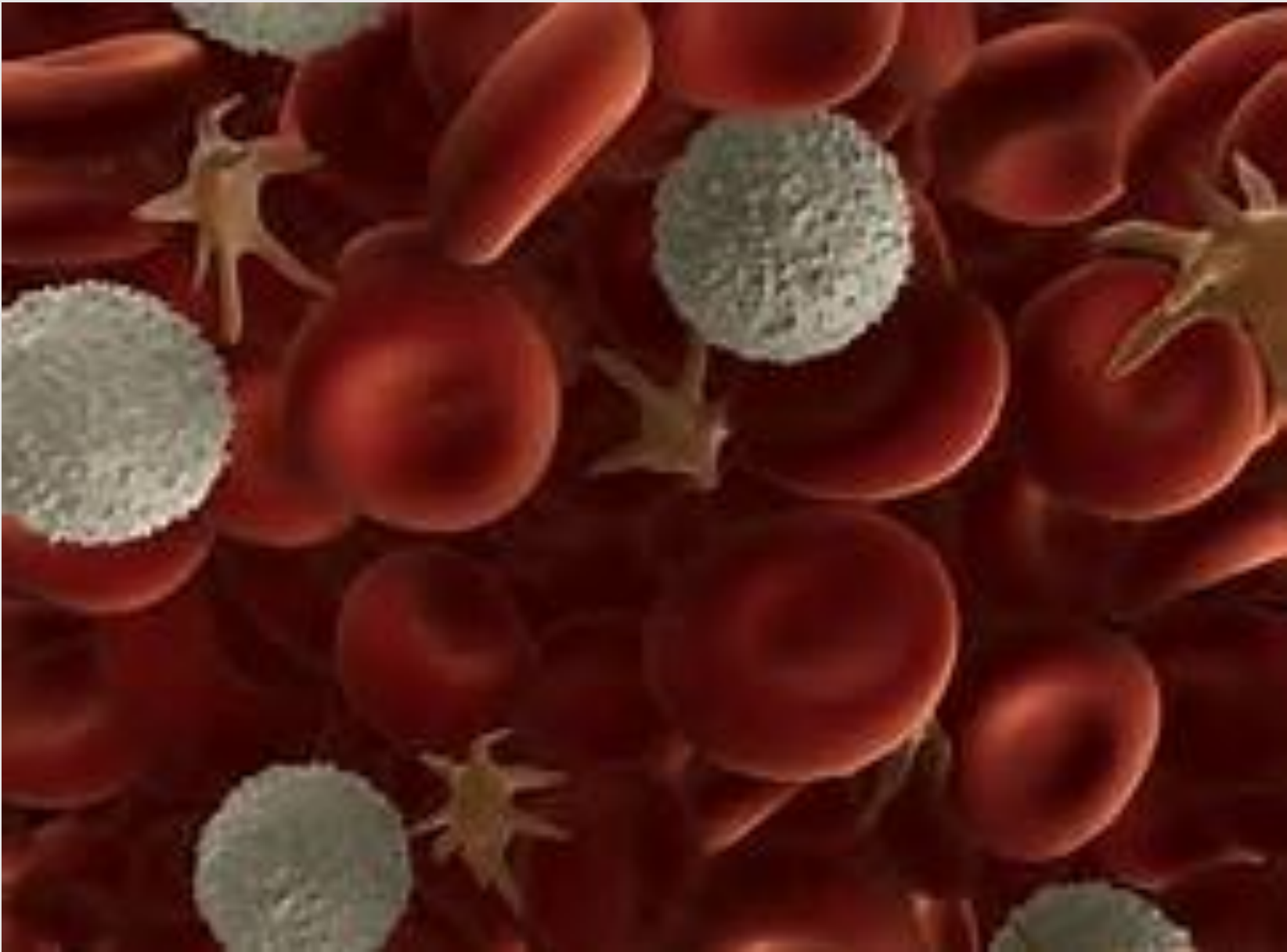
But you must not eat meat that has its

accounting. (*Genesis 9:4*)

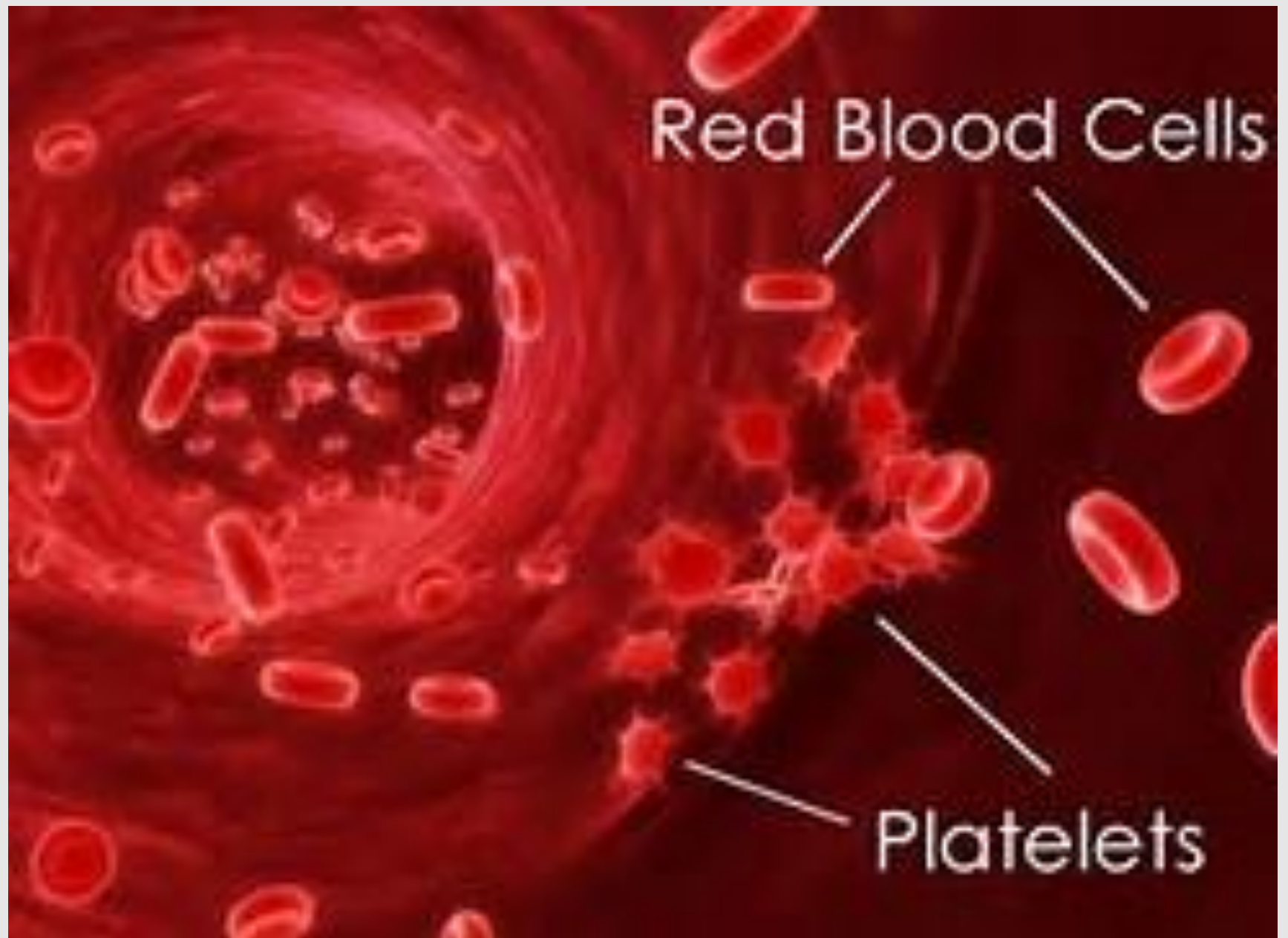


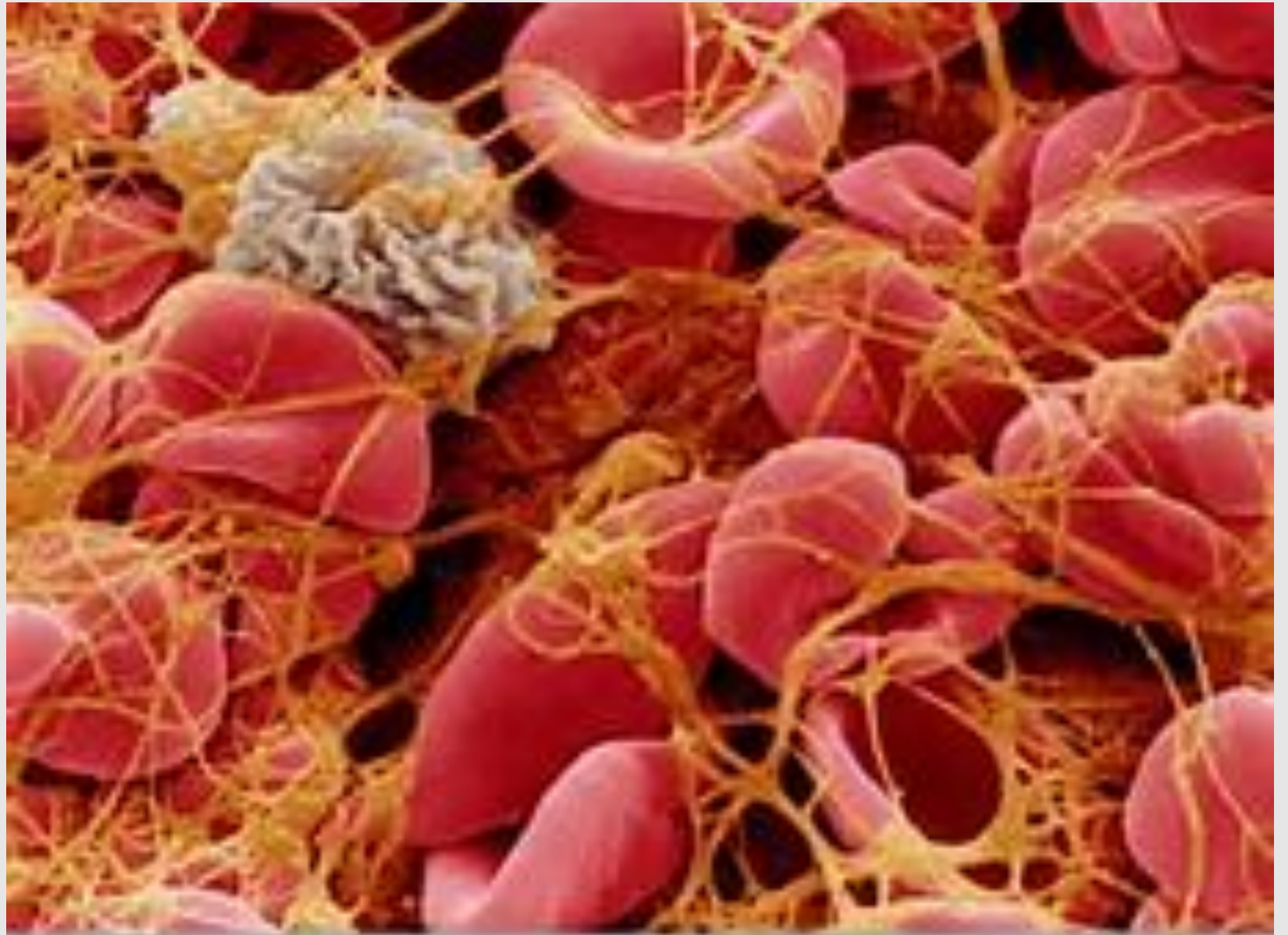












The followers of Jesus were **shocked** and **revolted**. Many **deserted** him! (*John 6:53-66*)

Blood is **CLEANSING!**

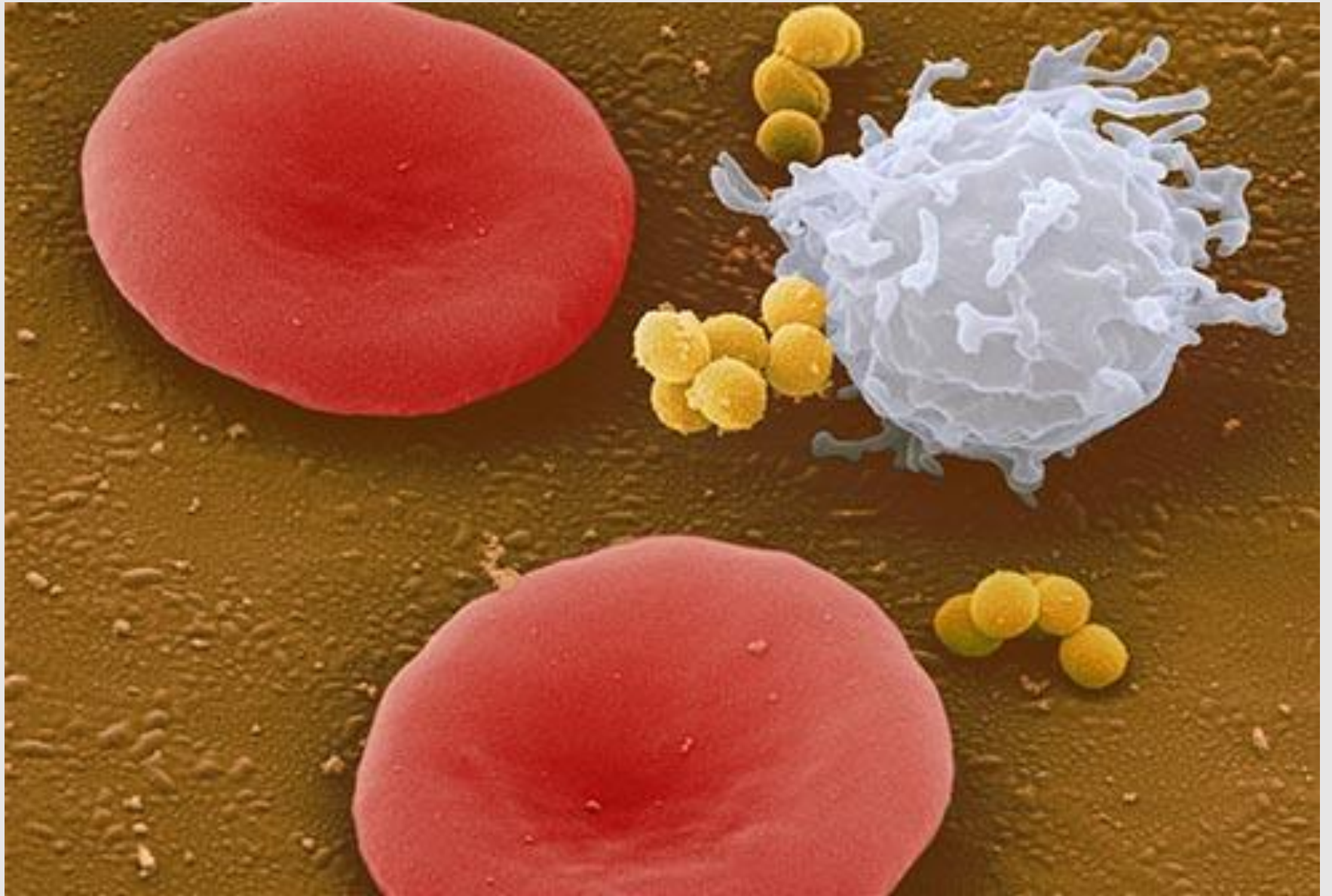
The Bible associates blood

“... and the BLOOD of Jesus, his Son, CLEANSSES us from all sins”
(1 John 1:7)

“These are those who have come out of the great tribulation. They have WASHED their robes and made them white in the BLOOD of the Lamb” *(Revelation 7:14)*

Blood cleanses **every cell** ...
absorbing toxins, wastes,
and debris





Cleansing of sin is made possible
by the blood of Christ.

How much more will the BLOOD OF CHRIST, who offered himself unblemished to God, CLEANSE our conscience from acts which lead to death, so that we may serve the living God! (*Hebrews 9:14*)

Red blood cell ... PROCESS =
humiliation and distress in order to
ingest contaminants of other cells

Blood is **TRIUMPH!**

SERUM ... contains the disease,
but it is weakened (defeated) ... by
the antibodies of someone else.

They fought the battle and **won**.
Their victory is **available** for the
new body to **appropriate**.

Jesus allowed himself to be
infected with **sin**.

God made him who had no sin to BE sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. *(II Corinthians 5:21)*

Jesus was a **carrier** of our disease,
but his power triumphed over it.

We do not have a high priest unable
to sympathize with our weaknesses,
but one who have been tempted in
every way, just as we are, yet
without sin. (*Hebrews 4:15*)

VACCINATION ... We overcome sin, not by our own resistance or vitality, but as a result of the victory of someone else.

Because he himself suffered when he was tempted, he is able to help those who are being tempted. (*Hebrews 2:18*)

They overcame him **by** the blood of the **lamb**. (*Revelation 12:11*)

This goes beyond **shed** blood.

It is the victory of **shared** blood!
