FOLLOW THE STAR

(Matthew 2:1-12)

Why did God choose a <u>star</u> to guide the men from the Far East to Bethlehem? Why not a cloud (Israelites), an angel (shepherds), or dream (Joseph)? Perhaps he simply chose something these men were familiar with or perhaps he wanted the symbolism to speak for the reality. The wise men followed the star until they found THE STAR!

STAR 1. A self-luminous, gaseous body of great mass, visible in the night sky

2. An outstanding talented or highly publicized performer who stands out among fellow performers

GIFT of the STARS = In the overwhelming blackness, ioneliness,
and void of outer space is a luminous diamond bright and beautiful a star.
*Into the crushing darkness of and shines

CERTAINTY of the STARS = Across history and civilizations, the fixed positions of stars have been depended upon for navigation and negotiation.
