How can we know that our Bible is the accurate, written, revelation of God? How can we be certain of its truth and truthfulness?

The starting place is its own testimony. It says so. The writers say they were eye witnesses of events that they record and claim that God impressed on them the very truths that they wrote. The Bible says that its <u>reliability</u> and <u>impact</u> is what it is because it is the very words of God (Is. 40:8, 55:10-11, Ps. 119:89, Mt. 5:18, Jn. 10:35, 11 Tim. 3:16)

The Bible does not seek human confirmation, but simply claims to be God's infallible Word, the all sufficient source of truth (Ps. 19:7, 119:160, Mt. 22:29, 1 Cor. 2:12-14, 1 Thess. 2:13) Jesus believed, affirmed, and taught that the Bible (O.T.) was God's Word and that it was written to prepare the world for his coming (Jn. 5:39, 17:17). These holy writings, our Bible, are not dependent upon human thought, critique, or desire. "By the Scriptures of the prophets, the commandments of the eternal God have been made known to all nations" (Rom. 16:25-27). We choose to accept or reject it. We do not get to choose what has been revealed to us.
