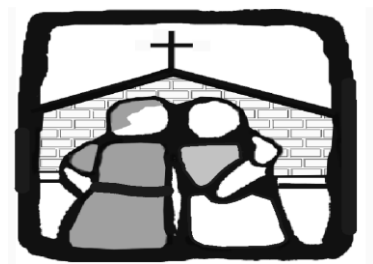

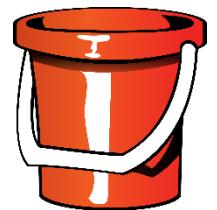

MALE AND FEMALE HE CREATED THEM

Genesis 1:26-27

- _____ ... _____ - substitute and representative, work and reward
- _____ - manage that part of creation not created in God's image
- _____/_____ - intellectual, relational, moral, and spiritual capacity
- _____ and _____ - equal but different

The male/female phenomenon of creation is part of God's _____. It is a profound glimpse of his glory and complexity made visible in human _____ and _____. This is not a phenomenon of history, culture, civilization or government. No human demands, laws, experimentations, or activism can change this design. Neither time nor evolution will undo what God has done. This is his _____ for _____.

A homosexual lifestyle is a life of rebellion against God's pattern, regardless of sincerity, emotions, arguments, or laws, which say otherwise. It is _____ to God and _____ to saying that God's design was unwise or impractical. Every Scriptural reference to homosexuality describes it as something, which "ought not be done" (Rom. 1:28).
