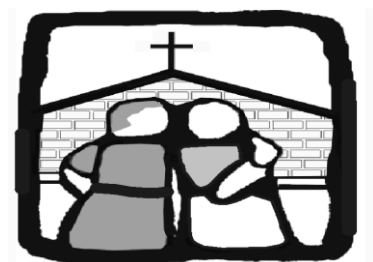

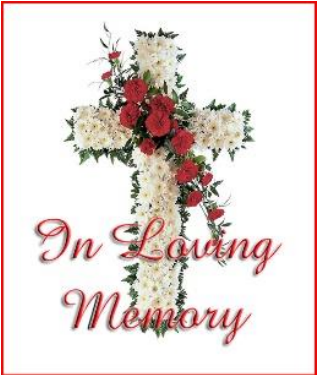

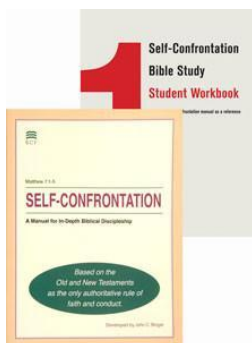

SUCCESS and SIGNIFICANCE (God’s View!)

(Acts 13:22) motive ... after God’s own _____ and _____
(Acts 13:36) resolve ... serve God’s _____ and _____

*The world’s version of success advertises money, pleasure, leisure, appearance, power, influence (brand!), and self-aggrandizement. Amazingly, _____ are suggested by God as worthwhile goals or impressive achievements. The word “success” does not even appear in the New Testament.

SOLOMON. Wealth, power, or independence _____
Solomon was successful in God’s eyes. But his desire to “distinguish right from wrong” was very significant to God.

SO ... God’s vision of success does not even take into account whether a person is _____, _____, or _____ [by man]. It is very possible that a poor unknown, unpopular, or powerless person is considered by God to be a sensational success. (*Matt. 5:3, 6:19-20, 19:30, Acts 4:13, I Cor. 1:26-30, James 2:5*).

God will use, bless, and reward countless millions of people who are not leaders, headliners, or heroes. They are followers, encouragers, suppliers, workers, givers, preparers, enablers, messengers, and helpers. Often, _____. Often _____ the _____.
