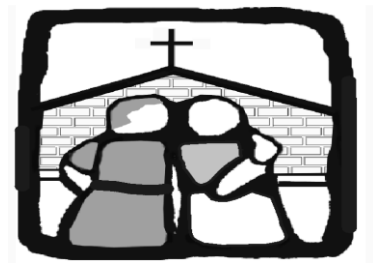

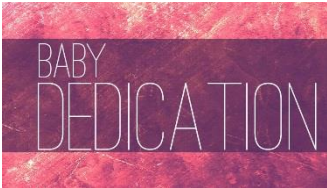

# BLOOD

They overcame him by the BLOOD of the LAMB...  
(Revelation 12:11)

## LIFE

Blood \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ every cell in my body ... oxygen, nutrients, and chemicals. Even color quickly changes with blood loss or infusion. God's people were repeatedly forbidden to eat bloody meat or drink the "lifeblood" (*Gen 9:4, Lev 3:17, 7:26-27, 17:11, Deut. 12:23 cf. Acts 15:29*). When Jesus told his followers they must "drink his blood" (*Jn. 6:53-57*), they were \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. Many \_\_\_\_\_ him (*Jn. 6:60-66*)! Why did Jesus use such an image? Because blood \_\_\_\_\_ to LIFE, and it is necessary that we receive his very life. We come to his table to \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ LIFE!

## CLEANSING

To be "washed in the blood" surely sounds like a misnomer. It is not! Scripture clearly \_\_\_\_\_ blood with cleansing (*Lev. 14:1-7, 21-32, I Jn. 1:7, Rev. 7:14*). The blood within my body cleanses \_\_\_\_\_ ... \_\_\_\_\_ toxins, wastes, and debris, which it dumps into lungs and kidneys for disposal. Cleansing of \_\_\_\_\_ is made possible by the blood of \_\_\_\_\_ (*Heb. 9:14*). The very process that a red blood cell goes through to absorb the other cell's contaminants conveys a picture of \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ on its part. As with Christ (*II Cor. 5:21*).

## TRIUMPH

The success of "vaccination" is one of the great stories of human history, saving millions of lives on every portion of our planet. An infant is born out of a sterile womb, unable to fight off a disease until they have developed antibodies. As immune systems grow, they become more tough and wise. But each new disease encountered brings great risk ... the white blood cells do not know how to unlock its code or destroy it.

The miracle of serum is that it \_\_\_\_\_ the disease, but it is \_\_\_\_\_, already whipped by the powerful antibodies of \_\_\_\_\_. That person fought the disease and \_\_\_\_\_. Their victory is \_\_\_\_\_ for the new body to \_\_\_\_\_ and build into their own system.

As with vaccination, we overcome sin, not by \_\_\_\_\_ resistance or vitality, but as the result of a battle that has already been won within someone else. We receive power over sin by His victory (*Heb. 2:18, Rev. 12:11*).

\*This goes beyond \_\_\_\_\_ blood. It is the victory of \_\_\_\_\_ blood!
