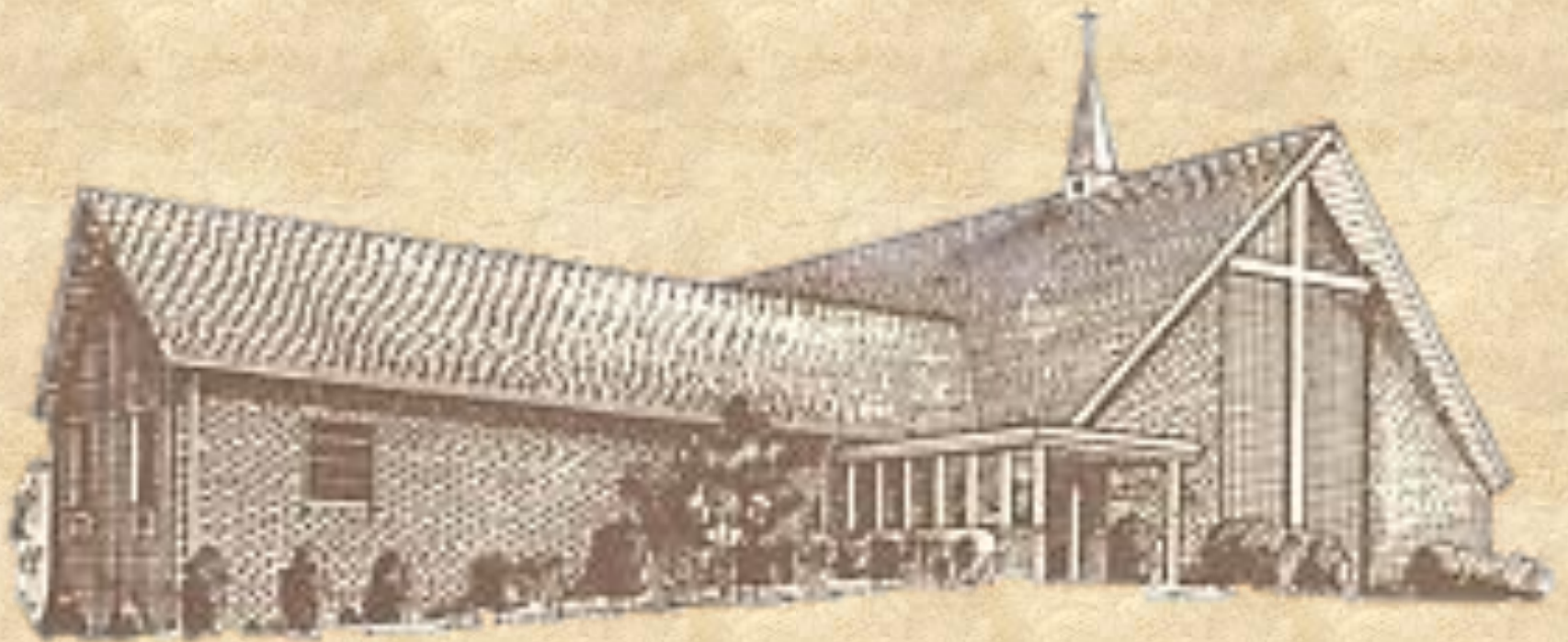

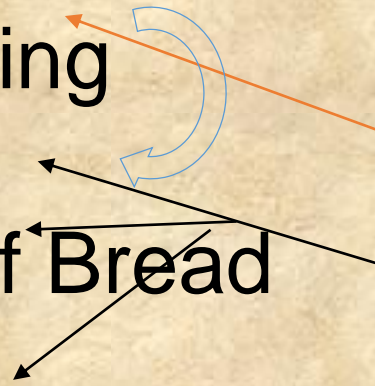

Think of “church” like **FOOD!**

Hebrews 10:

Not only is it **necessary** for us individually to have that **frequent contact** with the body of Christ (other believers), but we have a **corporate responsibility** to meet together in order to **help each other**.

vs. 24 – “*consider*”

concentrated attention

... stir one another toward **love** and
good works

vs. 25 – “*not neglecting to meet*”

How can we stir one another
unless we meet.

Regular fellowship with believers
is an essential ingredient for
growth as a Jesus follower.

vs. 26 – “*go on sinning*”

We are to **avoid** and **abandon** sin, why shy away from **sharing your struggles** in order to help each other.

Neglecting to meet together (church/small groups) has a direct correlation to a rejection of Christ's sacrifice for your sin.

Acts 2:24 – They **devoted** themselves
... **added** to their **number** **day** by
day.
