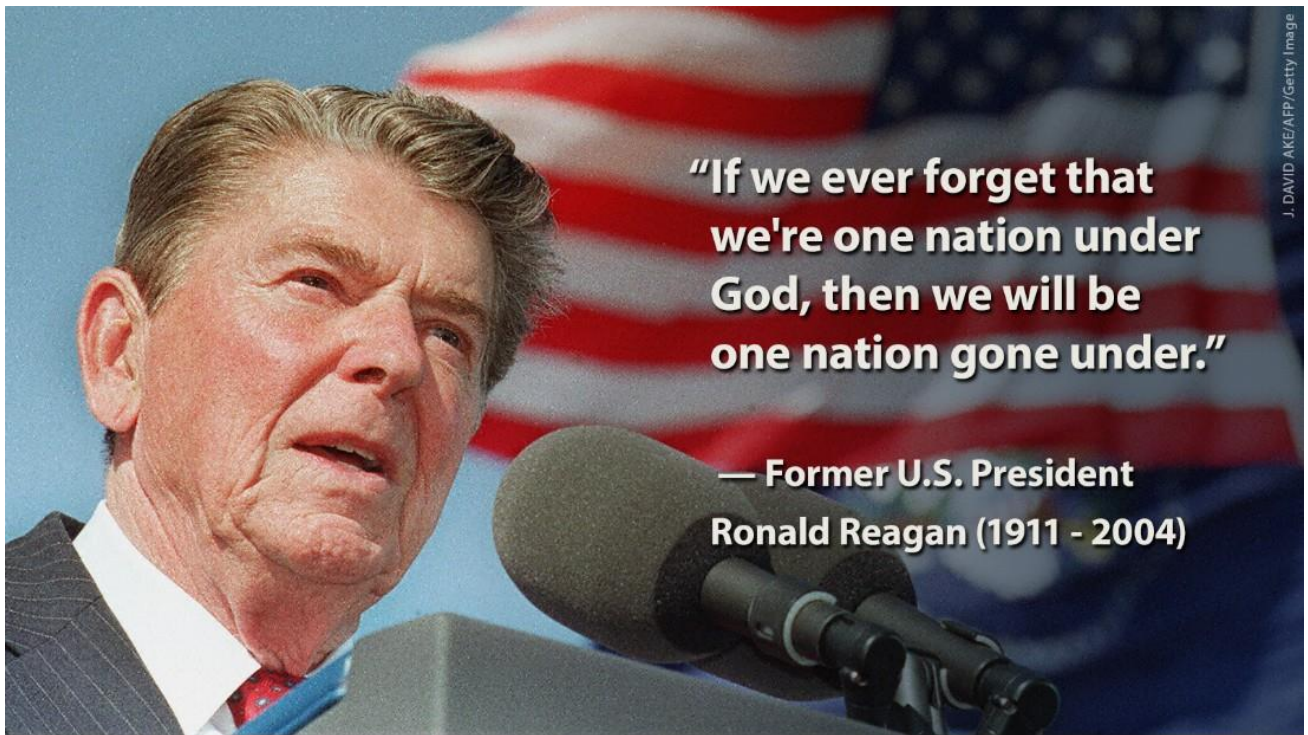
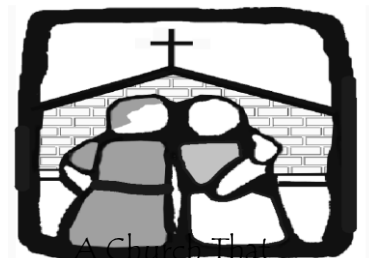

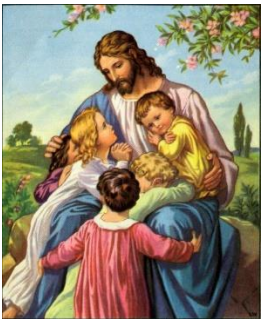

# INTEGRITY

(Exodus 20:15)

(Word #8)

1. Possessions are \_\_\_\_\_ to give, not \_\_\_\_\_ to steal (*Acts 17:25*). (Theft is an affront to God who gave that property to that person. The wealth or resources of a victim are no excuse or reason for theft.)
2. Both \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ theft is wrong (*Col. 3:22-25*) (Theft can be “taking” or “refusing to give”.)
3. \_\_\_\_\_ > \_\_\_\_\_ > \_\_\_\_\_ > \_\_\_\_\_ (*Eph. 4:28*)  
(This is God’s design and intention for humanity.)

At that time, I was saved from being a thief by finding everything locked up!  
But now, I am saved from being a thief because Christ has changed by heart.

# SECURITY

(Exodus 20:17)

(Word #10)

\*This final commandment anticipates the NT teaching of Jesus ... that sin really lies in the *heart* and not in the hands, in *attitude* more than action, in *desire* more than deed.

1. Abundant \_\_\_\_\_ does not equal abundant \_\_\_\_\_ (*Luke 12:15*).
2. Desire for possessions \_\_\_\_\_ our desire for God (*Matt. 6:24, Col. 3:5*)
3. The \_\_\_\_\_ we have, the \_\_\_\_\_ we are consumed by worldly responsibilities (*Luke 12:16-34*).
4. \_\_\_\_\_ child can rest securely in what \_\_\_\_\_ has given them for that moment (*Phil. 4:11, Heb. 13:5-6*).

There is not enough money printed to guarantee security. Security and peace concerning the future only comes from trusting God. He can give me contentment and happiness with the goods and resources he has given me.
