

NO WAY!

Because there is RIGHT and WRONG, our lives are filled with moral choices. Jesus described two destinies that lie at the end of either a broad road with a wide gate <u>or</u> a narrow road with a small gate (Matthew 7:13-14). If you do not like to make decisions... tough! Decisions are inescapable. Quite often the wisdom or foolishness of your choice boils down to the simplicity of YES or NO. And because our world and our human nature is fallen, it seems that our default position is YES. So living for God often means that we must summon the courage to say, "No." Long term reward often means NO to short term pleasure. <u>And</u> saying NO is not just about refusing bad things, but often about refusing something good in order to have something better!
