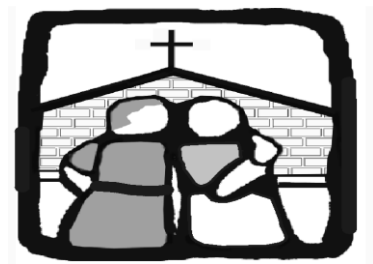

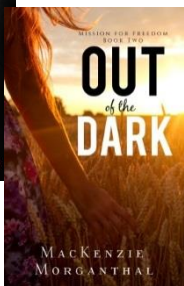
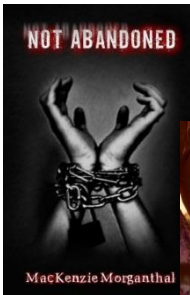
John Buchanan is temporarily living at Western Maryland Center for rehabilitation following back surgery. He also undergoes dialysis there.
