

None of these are the focus of the Bible's message about

Jesus. These are all important. But, above all else, Jesus
came into the world to die (Acts 2:23). On the cross, God's
justice and God's love ceased to contradict each other.

The demands of both were satisfied (Heb. 9:14). "It is
finished" (John
