



Demonic influence may affect physical health or exhibit similar symptoms to mental illness, easily leading to confusion. We are told to "test" the spirits (1 John 4:3), which means to confront the individual with the \_\_\_\_\_\_ and

<u>SUICIDE</u>. No doubt mental illness has resulted in suicide. In many other instances suicide is motivated by self-loathing, self-pity, hatred of life, fear of suffering, revenge, etc. Given the fact that God creates each life and ordains the span of each life *(Ps. 139:16, Job 14:5)*, it seems that premediated suicide is dishonoring to God and a grave sin.
