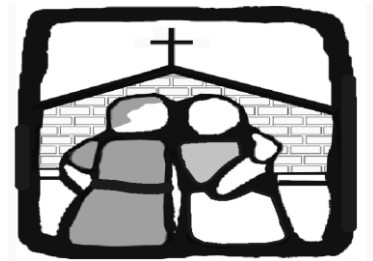

## ANOTHER COUNSELOR

### **John 14:16**

#### **“I will ask... the Father will give”**

The Holy Spirit came as God’s wide spread \_\_\_\_\_ after Jesus left (*14:2, 18, 15:26, 16:5-7*). Not bound by physical body or location (as Jesus was), the Holy Spirit promotes and advances the work which Jesus began... God’s Kingdom, God’s people, God’s purpose \_\_\_\_\_.

#### **“another Counselor”**

As the disciples had traveled and lived with Jesus, he had always been \_\_\_\_\_ to them. On call. Nearby. At hand. The descriptive word that Jesus used (Greek = **paraclete**) emphasizes this very aspect of the Holy Spirit. Invisible... but right there! Ready. Resourceful. He does not come near simply because we call. Rather, he is called alongside of us \_\_\_\_\_ our trials, fears, and needs! Like a GPS response triggered by location, the response of the Holy Spirit is activated by our insufficiency, our helplessness.

#### **“to be with you forever”**

In the Old Testament period, the Spirit was given to individuals for a particular mission or task (*Judges 13:24-25, 15:14-16*). This promise was something new... not simply \_\_\_\_\_ us, but \_\_\_\_\_ us... not simply for a \_\_\_\_\_ or a \_\_\_\_\_, but for our entire \_\_\_\_\_. He \_\_\_\_\_ our heart unto the day of redemption (*Eph. 4:30*). Though we grieve him, he \_\_\_\_\_ us by his power until our salvation is fully attained.

### **BASIC**

- When I ask/trust Christ to forgive and save me, I \_\_\_\_\_ the Spirit (*1 Cor. 12:13*).
- The Spirit gives me \_\_\_\_\_ to overcome, persevere, and witness (*Acts 1:8*).
- \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ with other Christians is prompted and promoted by the Spirit (*Eph. 4:3-6*).
