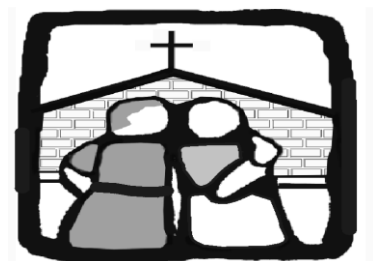

John 14:16

“I will ask... the Father will give”

The Holy Spirit came as God’s wide spread _____ after Jesus left (*14:2, 18, 15:26, 16:5-7*). Not bound by physical body or location (as Jesus was), the Holy Spirit promotes and advances the work which Jesus began... God’s Kingdom, God’s people, God’s purpose _____.

“another Counselor”

As the disciples had traveled and lived with Jesus, he had always been _____ to them. On call. Nearby. At hand. The descriptive word that Jesus used (Greek = **paraclete**) emphasizes this very aspect of the Holy Spirit. Invisible... but right there! Ready. Resourceful. He does not come near simply because we call. Rather, he is called alongside of us _____ our trials, fears, and needs! Like a GPS response triggered by location, the response of the Holy Spirit is activated by our insufficiency, our helplessness.

“to be with you forever”

In the Old Testament period, the Spirit was given to individuals for a particular mission or task (*Judges 13:24-25, 15:14-16*). This promise was something new... not simply _____ us, but _____ us... not simply for a _____ or a _____, but for our entire _____. He _____ our heart unto the day of redemption (*Eph. 4:30*).
