

The NT refers to Christians as "believers." I cannot <u>be</u> a Christian without believing certain fundamental facts or doctrines.

The NT (also) refers to Christians as "children of God." One does not become a child by "believing" something. Children are related to parents. I cannot be a Christian without having a fundamental relationship with God.

"This man was... sitting in his chariot reading the book of Isaiah the prophet" (Acts 8:28)

I <u>BELIEVE</u> that God has given reliable information (Bible)

"He was led like a sheep to the slaughter... Tell me, who is the prophet talking about? (8:34)

I BELIEVE the message centers on one unique person (Christ)

He was led... he was deprived... his life was taken..."
(8:32-35)

I BELIEVE Christ's

accomplishments are "good news" for my condition.

(repentance)

"Philip began with that very passage and told him the good new about Jesus." (8:35)

I BELIEVE this transaction is God's <u>offer</u> of <u>life</u>, and I choose to <u>receive</u> it! (faith)

"Why shouldn't I be baptized?"

I BELIEVE that I must deny my own pride and identify with Christ. (baptism)

"... and the eunuch went on his way rejoicing." (8:39)

I BELIEVE I must <u>pursue</u> the implications and victory of the <u>Christian life</u>.
