

### ONE + ONE = ONE

Matthew 19:3-12

Q = Is it acceptable to divorce your partner? (3)

A = NO. You (or any other person) must not separate what God has joined (6)

A) The standard of marriage applies until \_\_\_\_\_ occurs (1 Cor. 7:39, Rom. 7:1-3)

B) The standard of marriage should \_\_\_\_\_ Couples to fix \_\_\_\_\_ in the relationship (2 Cor. 7:10-11)

In the instance of a broken marriage, Moses insisted *(Deut. 24:1)* a BILL of DIVORCE must be granted (providing protection and allowing remarriage). Jesus said, "Moses did this because your hearts were hard." POINT: Moses provided for this contingency, but did not imply that this contingency was good or right. He was \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ something, but he was not \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ or \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ it. Moses never said that it was acceptable, yet he tried to limit its sinfulness and control its consequences. Moses was seeking to keep \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (abandonment of marriage) from becoming \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ (abandonment, then a later denial of such and claim upon the partner).

**Moses** = When a partner commits adultery they <u>must</u> be \_\_\_\_\_\_. (*Deut. 22:22*)

Jesus = When a partner commits adultery they <u>may</u> be \_\_\_\_\_\_. (*Mt. 5:32, 19:9*)

Moses = Upon divorce, remarriage is \_\_\_\_\_\_. (Deut. 24: 1-2)

Jesus = Upon divorce and remarriage, the \_\_\_\_\_\_ is guilty of adultery. (*Mk. 10:11-12*)

The \_\_\_\_\_\_ (non-responsible) of divorce is <u>caused</u> to commit adultery should they remarry. *(Mt. 5:32)* 

As God loves the widow, the orphan, the immigrant, or the exile, so he also loves the *divorced (Rom. 8:39)*. As God loves marriage, so he also expects those who are married to <u>love</u> their marriage and deny their own self interests in order to make teamwork and companionship a true *reality (Phil. 2:3-4, 1 Cor. 7:4)*. Any sin can be forgiven and any troubled marriage can be restored when hearts are surrendered to Christ and humility and mercy are given. *(1 Cor. 13:5-7, 1 Peter 3:8-9, 4:8, 1 Jn. 3:18-21)*
