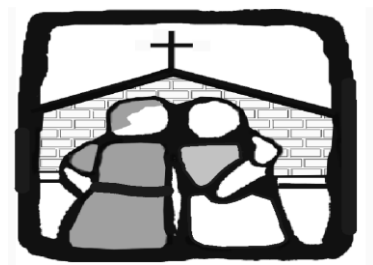

## ● yourself

My own sense of guilt following some foolish, wrongful or thoughtless  
action will have a withering effect upon me until it is corrected.

1. Determine to \_\_\_\_\_ a behavior, \_\_\_\_\_ a  
condition, \_\_\_\_\_ a repetition, or \_\_\_\_\_ a  
lesson (*II Cor. 7:9, Prov. 26:11*)
2. Issue an \_\_\_\_\_, repair a \_\_\_\_\_, or make a  
\_\_\_\_\_ to the fullest extent possible. (*Lk. 19:8-  
10, Num. 5:5-8*)
3. Resolve to \_\_\_\_\_ the simple reality of God's forgiveness  
offered to you (*Rom. 8:1-2*)

\*Sometimes people feel "guilt" over a circumstance that was beyond  
their control (victims, survivors, etc.). This is not true guilt and  
being "forgiven" is not necessary. It is emotional trauma that needs  
to be talked out, prayed through, and surrendered to God's perfect  
judgment (*Jm. 4:17, Jn 9:41, 1 Jn. 3:18-20*)
