## COLOSSIANS 2:20 - 3:17

Paul is writing a letter to a church he has never met (1:4), so he wants to make a big impact with this letter, telling them what it means to be a genuine follower of Jesus. (1:21, 2:6, 2:10, 2:13, 2:20, 3:1)

This passage marks the switch from theological to practical. Paul uses a series of contrasts to make his point.

Action needs to be taken

The words used in this passage (seek, set, put on, put off, etc.) are commands. ACTIONS!

All of the above does not happen on our own. Man made regulations lead to man made religion which has the appearance of wisdom (23), but does nothing in bringing about real life change.

## This only happens with complete surrender to Jesus!
