

• who was born of the Virgin Mary

"All this (vs. 18-21) took place to FULFILL what was spoken..." (1:22)

God > you > sign = (<u>origin</u>/information) virgin > conception > birth = (<u>method</u>/process) male child > name = (<u>identity</u>/purpose)

FLASHBACK (Isaiah 7)

DANGER: War; threat to annihilate the **house/line** of David (750 B.C.)

DISCLOSURE: "It will not happen" (vs. 7)

DARE: Have faith! (vs. 9) Ask for evidence! (vs. 10)

DOUBLE TALK: "Don't want to test the Lord!"

DECLARATION: Evidence will be given, regardless! God is WITH us! (Here and Now evidence AND Far Distant evidence... two babies

- a) Mahar Shalal enemies soon to be destroyed (7:15 8:4)
- b) Immanuel TOGETHER... God and Us (7:14)

Why all the fuss and fanaticism over "virgin birth?

- 1. NT = **absolute** and unequivocal (Mt. 1:18-20, Lk 1:26-37, 3:23)
- 2. OT = "seed of the woman" battles Satan (Gen. 3:15, Gal. 4:4, Rev. 12:17)
- 3. OT word (almah) always understood and translated as "virgin."
- 4. OT picture of <u>God dwelling</u> in a <u>tent</u> is a description of Jesus (*Jn. 1:14*) (This would <u>not</u> be an accurate picture if Jesus was a normal human baby!)
- 5. This is the <u>only explanation</u> for the sinless nature and Deity of Jesus. (From Mary the baby received blood and tissue, but the implanted nature was that of God.)

IM/ MANU/ EL

- *Emotionally*. **Assurance** of his **presence** in plenty/poverty, home/exile, suffering/health
- Spiritually. <u>tempted</u> by sin, <u>overwhelmed</u> by doubt, <u>consumed</u> by bitterness
