WHO CARES

(Jeremiah 12:1-4) "Lord, I am struggling"

- confusion
- anger

(Jeremiah 12:5) "You don't know the ending and you aren't trusting me"

- Need to grow in <u>understanding</u>
- Need to grow in <u>faith</u>

ANALOGY ... a race (opponents and terrain)

POINT: You are trying to live in an imaginary world while you actually live in the real world. You have no long term perspective. You think the current situation is permanent. It is not!(12:14)

Implication: Strong faith can handle horses and thickets!

Implication: You should not have to be coddled or protected <u>in</u> order to keep your faith!

Impart an <u>awareness</u> and <u>knowledge</u> of God

Build a <u>strength</u> and <u>conviction</u> which <u>survives</u> trials

Cultivate a <u>power</u> and <u>poise</u> which <u>handles</u> persecution

Model a <u>commitment</u> and <u>longevity</u> which <u>transcends</u> disappointments

Generate a <u>desire</u> and <u>delight</u> in <u>serving</u> others

Instill a <u>confidence</u> and <u>maturity</u> which <u>flourishes</u> without "help"
