

He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. (Colossians 1:15)

Adam #1 = a <u>man</u> in the <u>image</u> of God Adam #2 = <u>image</u> of God into a <u>man</u> God was the <u>pattern</u> used so that Adam was fashioned <u>after</u> his likeness/image.

Jesus was God <u>distilled</u> into an earthling, a human who <u>was</u> the image.

Adam #1 = <u>part of</u> creation Adam #2 = <u>over</u> creation



Jesus was not an <u>affiliation</u> or <u>approximation</u> or <u>abbreviation</u> of God.

He was both the <u>representation</u> AND <u>manifestation</u> of God. To the world of flesh he was the **incarnation** of God.

Gladness of creation = <u>from</u> Christ Glory of creation = <u>unto</u> Christ Glue which adheres creation = <u>within</u> Christ
