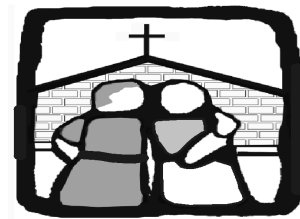

Women's Exercise Class will break for the summer. Date to resume in September to be announced.

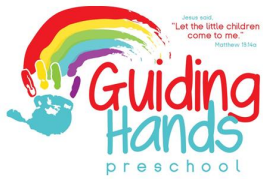
NEXT SUNDAY: Church picnic at Rhodes Grove Pavilion.
