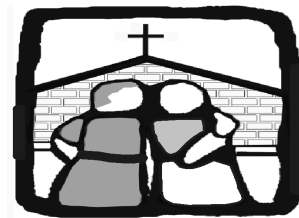

JUSTIFIED KILLING...SELF DEFENSE
