Under AUTHORITY

Wife > Submission... as is fitting in the Lord Child > Obedience... as pleases the Lord Slave > Diligence... with reverence for the Lord

Exercising AUTHORITY

Husband > Love

Parent > Encouragement

Master > Equity

The CHRISTIAN ethic = mutual obligation and responsibility rather than <u>rights</u>, <u>privileges</u>, or <u>entitlements</u>.

Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ *(Eph. 5:21)*

GOD'S STANDARD

MARRIAGE – love governs partnership

PARENTING – leadership balances discipline with encouragement

WORKER – love for God motivates performance and attitude

BOSS – awareness of God inspires f fairness to employee

In a Christian marriage there is a distinction of <u>role</u>, but no distinction of <u>worth</u>.

In a Christian family emphasis is on value of **persons**, rather than value of **performance**.

Cultivation of <u>freedom</u> = key to <u>personhood</u>

 Commitment to <u>responsibility</u> = key to <u>relationship</u>
