

person... descendants, land, and "blessing" (Gen. 12, 17)
plan... covenant (relationship) Word (Rom. 3:1-2), and Savior (Gen. 49:10, Rom 9:4-5)
The Jewish role was to be that of ______ (holy nation) and ______ (priests) to all the other nations (Ex. 19:3-6). God blessed them and they were to bless others by providing ______ (attraction)
and ______ (persuasion). * No different than the church today.

However, the Jews became enamored with their religions culture (laws) and proud of their exclusive tradition (identity). Holiness was defined by outward appearances rather than inner desires. When Jesus excoriated this version of religion, they (as a whole) refused to listen. When he told them he was their "Christ" and by his <u>self</u> sacrifice would end the need for their religious (sacrificial) system, they refused to believe him *(Jn. 7:15-19, 27-30, 8:31-59, Rom. 9:30-33, 10:16-21)*.

*_____... tradition, position, or ambition is unimpressive (*Mt. 9:13*) *______... dismantling a "works" mentality and switching to "faith" (*Mk. 10:15, Jn. 6:28-29*)



 <u>Covenant of land/favor is everlasting...</u> Old Testament prophecies still apply. God still recognizes <u>political</u> reality of Israel (1948). Temple/Sacrifices will be restored (*Rom. 11:28-29*).

 Purpose of political Israel is finished... Old Testament prophecies have been fulfilled... God has affirmed a <u>new</u> covenant (*Jer. 31:31-34, Lk. 22:20*) based on a "new" and "better" way (*Heb. 8:7-13,* 10:20). Those who receive Jesus as Lord (Christian church) are the <u>new</u> or <u>true</u> Israel

(Act. 13:45-48, Rom. 2:28-29, 9:6-8, Gal. 3:7-9, 19, 26-29, 6:15-16, Phil. 3:3, Mt. 21:42-45). This is precisely the point of Daniel's prophecy about future political kingdoms (2:36-45, note vs. 44). Regarding 1948, this "birth" of a nation is no different in significance than other nations established under similar circumstances.

HEAVEN? Every person given eternal life in heaven will be there because they have "converted" to saving ______ in _____ (*Jn. 14:6, Acts 4:12*). This will surely include "former" Jews, Muslims, atheists, etc.
