Temporary vs. Permanent

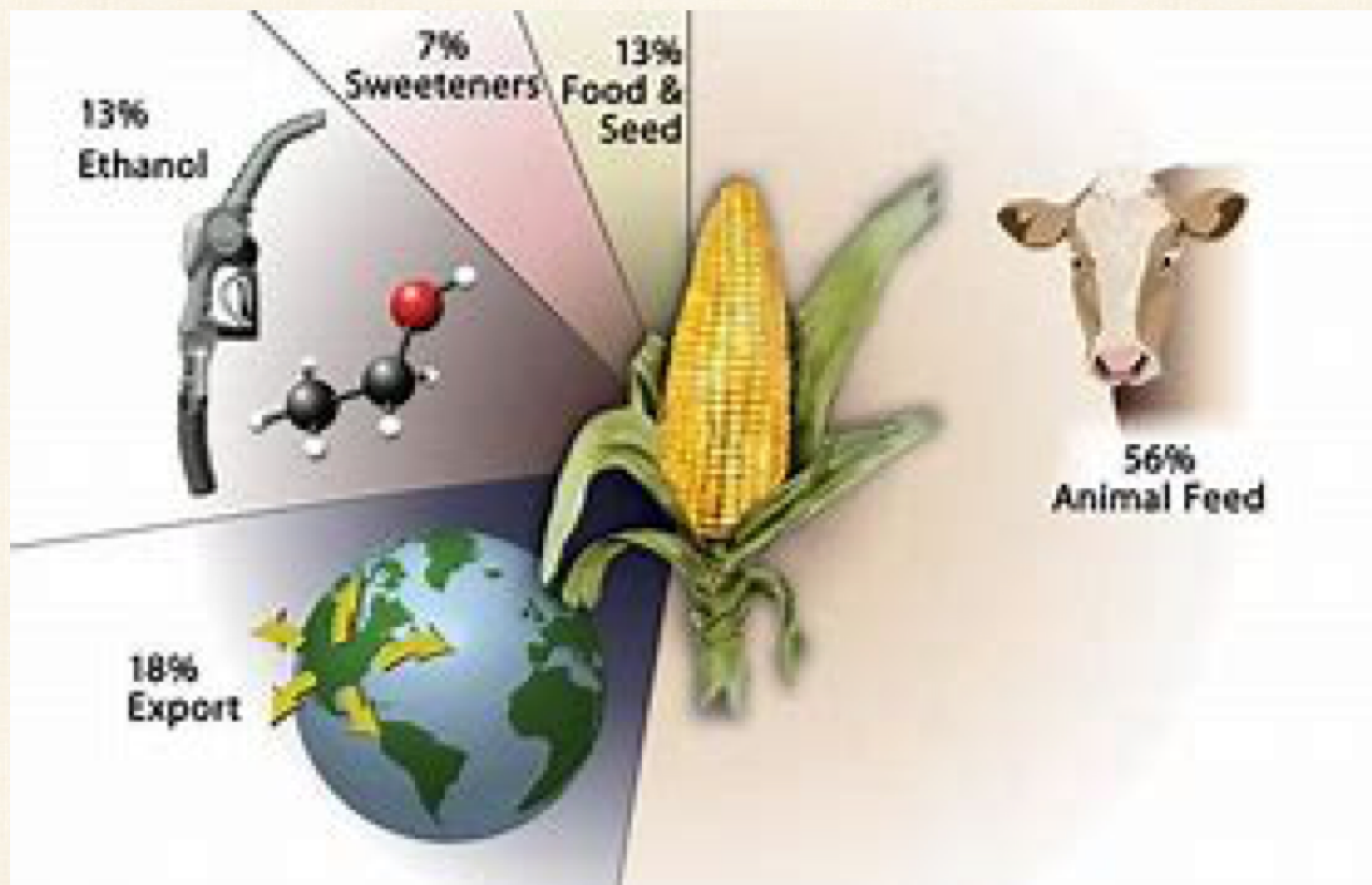
a) Perspective

Wheat vs. Weed *(Mathew 13)*

For every scriptural **exhortation** to repent/believe in Christ, there is a **warning** against refusing Christ.

No eye has seen, no ear has heard,
no mind has conceived what God
has prepared for those who love him.
(1 Corinthians 2:9)

On this mountain the Lord Almighty will prepare a feast of rich food for all peoples, a banquet of aged wine, the best of meats. On this mountain he will destroy the shroud that enfolds all peoples, the sheet that covers all nations. He will swallow up death forever.
