ONE FLOCK and ONE SHEPHERD



Throughout the entire Bible God uses the analogy of SHEPHERD/SHEEP to describe the relationship between himself and his chosen, saved people.

*Appropriate

(there are some similarities!)

Understandable

(ANE world = prominent, ubiquitous, familiar, necessary to everyone!)

Spiritual Life > Sheep Life (John 10)

1. Concerning God's (everlasting) life, people are **hungry** and **helpless**. They need a guide and caretaker, a SHEPHERD.

2. Jesus Christ is the ONE God sent for all **people** throughout all **ages** ... the only true GOOD SHEPHERD.

3. Every other person or philosophy which promises everlasting life is a "thief, hired hand, or stranger" and will ultimately **steal** or **destroy** my dream of heaven.

- Do I trust and follow Jesus?
- Do I hear and heed his voice?
- Do I <u>refuse</u> to <u>follow</u> the stranger's voice?

Characteristic of "leadership"

THIEF = <u>selfishness</u> (greed)

HIRED HAND = <u>service</u> (convenience)

SHEPHERD = <u>sacrifice</u> (love)

Shepherd's goal

- know the people
- <u>lay down</u> their life for the people
- bring "other/outside" people into the flock
- <u>lead</u> people into nourishment and security

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
