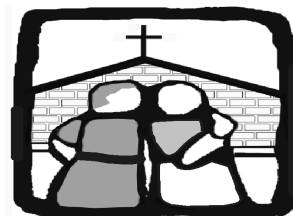

## CAN ANYTHING GOOD COME OUT OF THIS?

(Hebrews 2)

Angels are hard to figure out! They have super human power, yet are sent to serve humans (Heb. 1:14)

Jesus, in remarkable love, BECAME lower than the angels.  
God, in remarkable love, ALLOWED Jesus to be so humbled.

\_\_\_\_\_ = subjection of everything, particularly "death"  
\_\_\_\_\_ = short time  
\_\_\_\_\_ = extreme glory and honor  
\_\_\_\_\_ = dominion of all life, space, matter, time  
(no exceptions)

God's only option, if he would reverse the curse (DEATH), was to absorb the impact of his own penalty. He could not cancel the penalty, but he could pay the penalty. Death, then, had no more claim on anyone. Yet this must be done in a way which made its merit available to people. So, CHRIST TASTED DEATH FOR EVERYONE (2:9)
