

SLOW TO LEARN

Hebrews 5:11-14

- **Expectation**
 - **Disappointment**
 - **Frustration**
 - **Accusation**

ISSUE = “forever priesthood” of Christ

*This had profound implications
for these Hebrew (Jewish) people!

- A. It meant a **severing** of **ties** with the old (Jewish) order of priests/sacrifices
- B. It meant “selling out” and “pressing on” in Christ ...
commitment to **truth**

Why were these folks “sluggish” about this?

The **INTELLECT** is not eager to entertain what the **HEART** does not want to accept!

Our TEMPTATION ... “believe”
and then **settle in** at the point of
accepting “doctrine” and make
this the entire package of our
Christian **experience**.

Grow into maturity i.e. Make the
implications into **applications**.

Seek a higher level of maturity by embracing **new experiences**.

Accept **growth** by accepting
responsibility such as teaching
and leading.

Embrace FAITH as a journey
holding God's hand rather than
intellectual “reasoning”.

Understand God's **frustration**
with the man-child and his
elation with serious adulthood.

LEARN (implication) > **PRACTICE**
(application) > **TEACH** (propagation)

Arrange the ABC's into complex
words and **speak** Christ through
your life!
