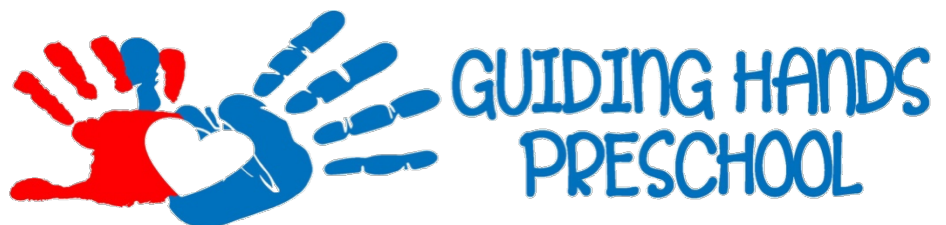

## THE (TALL) ORDER OF MELCHIZEDEK

**Mysterious Mel...** king/priest “Righteousness and Peace”

a) bread and wine                      b) “Blessed be Abraham! Blessed be God!”

\*Abraham spontaneously \_\_\_\_\_ an offering/tithe/portion (*Genesis 24*)

### Hebrews 7

Mel = different from every priest in entire history of Abraham's family (Jewish)

• no record of \_\_\_\_\_                      • no record of \_\_\_\_\_ / \_\_\_\_\_

Therefore, authority based on God's pronouncement, rather than earthly qualification

“line” = \_\_\_\_\_ (Aaron)                      “order” = \_\_\_\_\_ (Melchizedek)

### ARGUMENTS FOR NEW PARADIGM

- \_\_\_\_\_ a) People = Priests b) Priests (in Abraham) > Melchizedek (*vs. 4-10*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a) Priests = Levi      b) Jesus = Judah (therefore, law is superseded!) (*vs. 11-14*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a) law remains weak      b) Jesus is “indestructible” (*vs. 15-19*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a) God's permission (eligibility)      b) God's choice (*vs. 20-22*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a) short term              b) permanence (*vs. 23-25*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ a) sinful priest > daily      b) perfect priest > only one time (*vs. 27-28*)

*Difficult. Tedious. For us (today) this analysis seems irrelevant. We are past it.*

1. \_\_\_\_\_ is inspired, important, and beneficial (*11 Tim. 3:16*)

2. There are many manmade systems of "religion" hoping to appease the wrath or earn the pleasure of "God." Prior to the coming of Jesus, the \_\_\_\_\_ religion actually revealed by the true God was the laws/sacrifices of Moses to the children of Abraham (Jews). If Christ supersedes that, then \_\_\_\_\_ can be \_\_\_\_\_ that \_\_\_\_\_ also \_\_\_\_\_ every other religion's idea, system, or practice... ancient or modern (*Acts 17:22-31*)

3) The "intercessory" or \_\_\_\_\_ of Jesus is validated not simply because he was from a different tribe (Judah), but also from a different place (Heaven). It is not exercised on earth, but in a heavenly tabernacle (*7:25, 9:11, 23-24*). This means that our salvation \_\_\_\_\_ by earthly conditions or changes, laws or fads. It belongs to the \_\_\_\_\_, not the \_\_\_\_\_.

4. The sacrificial ritual was grand and impressive, yet kept men at a distance from God, separated (symbolically) by both priest and curtain. Christ was \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ coming together in a profound way that cleared away all the debris and left wide an opening *'by which we [individuals] draw near to God.'* (*7:19*)
