CONTEST, CONTRACT, COACH

(Hebrews 8)

BUT the game is already over! Their comments and criticisms help no one. The Sunday quarterback needs information and inspiration in real time. A rather than a!
Between the OWNER in their box [expectation] and the PLAYER on the field [potential] is the COACH on the sideline [strategy/strength]. The coach make victory before the game [preparation] and makes victory during the game [provision].
CHRIST OUR HIGH PRIEST
• beside the OWNER (8:1)
• up in defense of the player (7:25)
• all wrath and blame for each player (7:27)
• Acquires the OWNER'S for each play (8:2)
• player's comments and complements to OWNER (8:2)
• Mostly done in OWNER'S box, from of players (8:2,5)
NEW CONTRACT
The former contract emphasized performance and salary (reward) but had no
internal stimulus or motivation. Long on perfection but short on power! Many injuries and losses. Long ago (Jeremiah 31:31-34) the OWNER announced a new
contract which would reflect a different approach and much higher success rate.
✓ It would be based upon rather than
✓ It would be by the OWNER'S SON (therefore highly
motivated!) rather than a player/coach whose loyalties were divided (Moses)
✓ The Son/Coach would join the team and make <u>every preparation</u> necessary
prior to game day and then join the OWNER during the game
but
✓ New contract totally nullifies the former contract! No longer motivated by
salary but by love love the OWNER and love the OWNER

Our salvation is based upon what Christ <u>did</u> (past) and what he still does (present). He ministers on our behalf ... bringing to God the repentance, worship, or service of our hearts. He is our PRIEST before God. "Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks <u>through him</u> to God the Father." (Col. 3:17)
