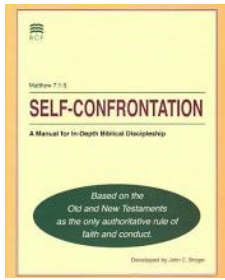
Tues., Sept. 8 – Breakfast!
