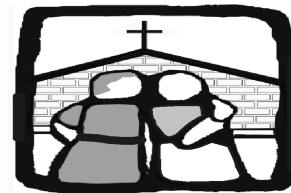

# YOU ARE MINE

(Isaiah 43)

- Like God, we \_\_\_\_\_
- Like God, we feel \_\_\_\_\_ regarding our creation
- Like God, we feel \_\_\_\_\_ over our creation
- Like God, we get \_\_\_\_\_ when our creation does not meet our expectations
- Like God, we get \_\_\_\_\_ if someone sabotages or destroys our creation
- Like God, we hope and plan to \_\_\_\_\_ a \_\_\_\_\_

THEREFORE, we should understand the \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ God has toward us!

1. God created you and he did not do that for your own sake! (1, 7, 21, 25)

2. God's protection over you is so pervasive that you really should live without fear! (1-2)
