God created you and he did not do that for your own sake!

*I tend to think about <u>my</u> own <u>problems</u> and listen most for <u>my</u> own <u>praise</u>.

God's protection over you is so pervasive that you really **should** live without fear!

*I tend to want God's protection because my life is **precious** to **myself**.

Perspective of *Isaiah 43* = The **purpose** of **my life** is precious to God.

God's passion for/toward you is so intense that he is willing to trade other lives for yours!

*When seeking to fulfill God's purpose, I should pray for my enemies, those who would interfere.

God's provision for you has [occasionally] been spectacular. Those special memories feed your faith. Great... but... "move on!"

*I tend to base my faith on the **solid footing** of the past. This pulls my focus away from the excitement of the present and the **hope** of the future.
