Reward

- √ <u>stimulus</u>... a boost to reinforce
 a desired outcome
- ✓ <u>return</u>... Something given in recompense... fulfillment/payment/Thank You!
- √ <u>always follows</u> the performance (never precedes)

Rewards are **DELIGHTFUL**

celebration of accomplishment

satisfying... recognition of work/skill/dedication/status

motivating... fuel for the journey

Rewards are **DANGEROUS**

- become the complete focus and block other <u>important</u> issues from our view
- become the complete motivation and eclipse other reasons for doing important things
- become our complete identity, so that we have no strength if <u>not</u> being rewarded

Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done.

(Rev. 22:12)

The Bible uses "reward" to refer to both positive and negative. This has the simple sense of what is <u>due</u> or <u>deserved</u>.

For the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done.

(Mt. 16-27)

POINT: This life has a follow-up!

a good deed...

√ to serve God

√ to glorify God

√ to impress people

On impressing people... Jesus said, "human praise will be your **only** reward"

Does God notice my <u>Attitude</u>... my <u>Work</u>... or my <u>Results</u>?

1. RESULTS

(accomplishment/achievement) are **God's** enterprise.

No rewards for us.

I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow. So neither he who plants or he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow. The man who plants and the man who waters have one purpose, and each will be rewarded according to his own LABOR.

(1 Cor. 3:6-8)

2. Labor will be rewarded

according to **potential**

according to motivation

according to **faithfulness**

3. Joyfulness or Reluctance (ATTITUDE) will be a consideration of reward

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as WORKING FOR THE LORD, not for men, since you know you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as your reward. It is the Lord Christ that you serve.

(Col. 3:23)

Amount/Type/Value of REWARDS that God will give are beyond our determination.

GOD DECIDES... who/what/why

AND... There can be no anger, argument, or jealousy. WHY?
*Because <u>all</u> rewards are simply <u>MERCY!</u>

For us...

a trophy/induction/ceremony usually marks an "ending" i.e. a <u>release</u> from <u>responsibility</u>

God's rewards have a very different orientation... credentials for <u>greater</u> responsibility.

What about "crowns" and "treasures"? These are simply earthly <u>symbols</u> of glory, honor, and immortality that are the spiritual rewards of living in God's presence.

And the word of the Lord came to Abraham in a vision, "I am your shield and your VERY GREAT REWARD."

(Gen. 15:1)
