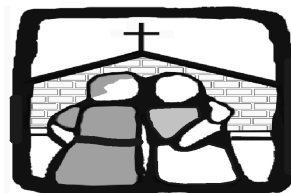

# THE CRY OF FAITH

(Mark 9:14-29)

Mountain top/Revelation > Back home/Bickering (14-16)

\*This world is filled with briars and battles. The blessings (mountain tops) we encounter are given for \_\_\_\_\_, not \_\_\_\_\_.

**Disappointments** (17-19). When you need and seek help and humans fail to deliver, do not let that disappointment \_\_\_\_\_ you from bringing your problem to the \_\_\_\_\_.

## Jesus vs. Satan

No \_\_\_\_\_ (20-21) facts rather than emotion

No \_\_\_\_\_ (23) complete confidence

No \_\_\_\_\_ (25) absolute authority

No \_\_\_\_\_ (25) not interested in temporary relief

Misdiagnosis! Many thought the boy was dead. Jesus knew better.

\*People may dismiss you as helpless, worthless, useless. They may think you have little to offer. Your obedience to God limits their interest in you. Their [worldly] diagnosis is that you have little value. Jesus says, "Not so!" (vs. 27)

## FRUSTRATION and CONNUNDRUM

1. Since I have authority [even over evil spirits], why am I not always able to drive them out? [cf. Mk. 6:7, Mt. 10:1]

2. How can I have faith and doubt at the same time? (vs. 24)

Jesus mentioned only \_\_\_\_\_ (Mt. 17:20)
